ACADEMY ENTRANCE STANDARD BASIC TRAINING

PURSUANT TO ILLINOIS PUBLIC ACT 87-182 each Illinois police agency and applicant applying for admission to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board Basic Training Academy shall provide certification that the applicant has not committed any felony or a crime involving moral turpitude, and is a person of good character. This requirement and standard must be satisfied before consideration acceptance into the academy.
